LOWERCASE FAMILY 1 (i I j) and FAMILY 2 (x only) OBJECTIVES: 45° pen angle, 5° slope. Family 1 - Straight line downstroke. Downstroke - top to bottom. Ascender - I. Descender - j. Serifs: soft angle entrance serif - i, soft angle exit serif - i and I, sharp angle entrance serif - j. One-stroke - I, two-stroke - i j. Trace with pen just above solid black letters (almost touching); touch pen to paper for all other letters.



CARDS & LETTERS, FLOURISHED CAPITALS & LOWERCASE

OBJECTIVES: 15° pen angle - capitals; 45° pen angle - lowercase (except s, z, and crossbar of f and t). OPTION: Flourished ascenders on b d h k l as on f with added height for all six ascenders; Flourished descenders on f and p as on g j y with added length for all six descenders including q. (With flourished ascenders & descenders use every other line on ruled lines, pages 61 and 64.) Optional flourish on e at end of sentence or end of person's name. Flourished capitals - H K M N U Y begin with flourish, B D E F P R T begin with downstroke.
