



This is the second workbook of a seven-part series. Designed for the beginning reader and writer, it introduces the alphabet one letter per page as well as words and sentences. Includes basic italic lowercase, capitals, and numerals. Illustrated.

Italic is a modern handwriting system based on enduring letterforms that are highly suited to rapid and legible writing. Italic conforms to natural, rhythmic hand movements. Italic builds on previously learned concepts and the letter shapes remain the same from basic to cursive, eliminating the abrupt leap from "ball and stick" to looped cursive. Selfassessment is an integral part of the Getty-Dubay program.
